ChatGPT (chat.openai.com) — best for writing, summarising, and brainstorming. The most versatile starting point.

Claude (claude.ai) — best for long documents, nuanced writing, and detailed step-by-step explanations.

Google Gemini (gemini.google.com) — best for research with real-time web access; integrates with Google Workspace.

4

Canva AI (canva.com) — best for presentations, posters, and social media graphics with no design skill needed.

5

Notion AI (notion.so) — best for organising notes, summarising meetings, and drafting structured work documents.

6

Microsoft Copilot — built into Word, Excel, and Outlook; best for graduates already in a Microsoft workplace.

7

Start with one tool only. Use it for 30 days before adding another. Depth beats breadth when building AI habits.
